CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Various Co-Curricular Activities are held under different Clubs to develop a child physically, morally, socially and mentally and to hone skills in co-scholastic areas.

Subject themed Exhibitions were displayed during the PTMs to demonstrate to the parents what the students have learnt during the week through the models, posters, artworks, presentations etc.

Regular Club Activities are held for the students to participate and display their calibre. Various Club Activities of all classes were conducted giving chance to the students to participate in Quiz, Debates, and Speeches etc. to enhance their knowledge on current issues as well help them to develop general awareness.

Eco Club/Science Club celebrated Earth Day, Van Mahotsav, Nature Conservation Day, National Energy Conservation Day and other occasions in a quest to save our Mother Earth. Activities related to Say No to Plastics, Road Safety, Save Water, Save Soil, Save animals etc. kept the students of all classes inquisitive and engaged in contributing towards the betterment of the environment.

Mock Parliament (Social Science Club) led the students discover about parliamentary system of our democratic country and its process through live presentation. Students of classes VIII to XII actively participated in bringing a Parliamentary Proceeding alive in the school premises.
